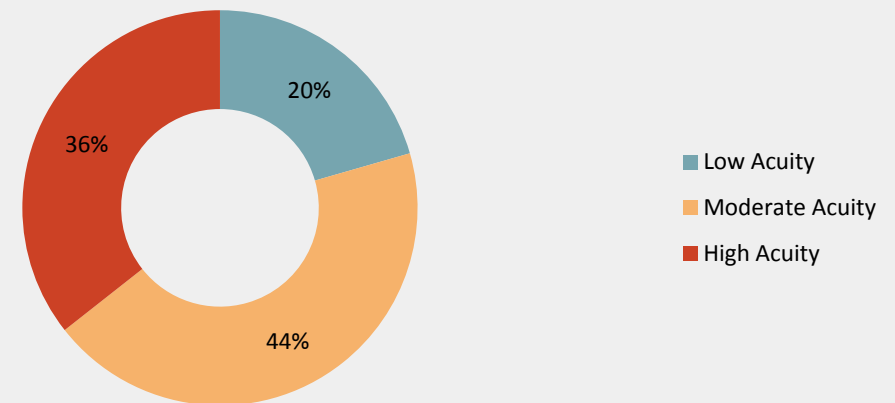

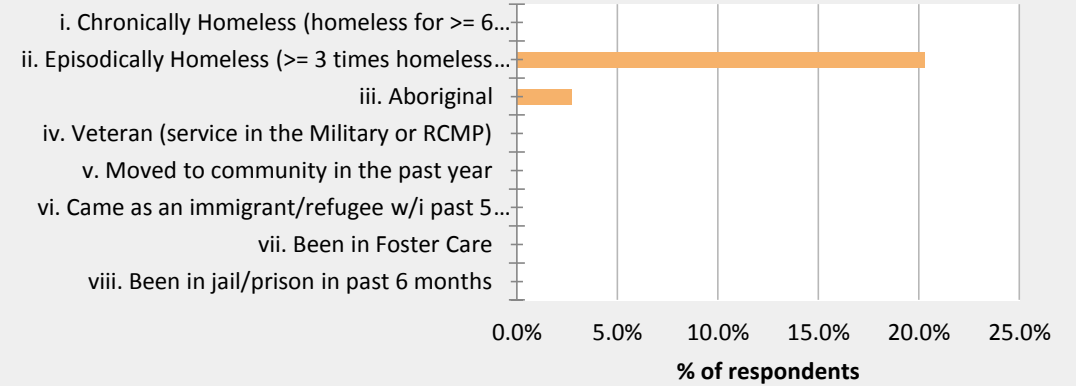

VI-SPDAT Scoring / Housing Intervention Breakdown



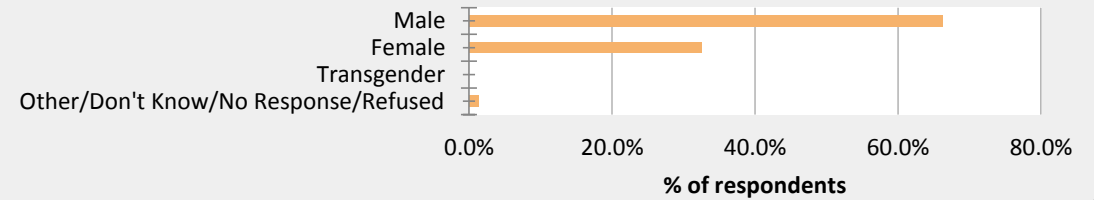

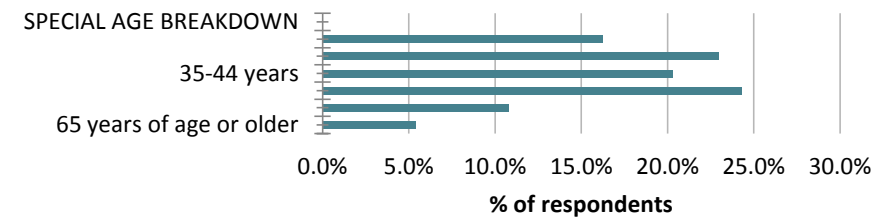

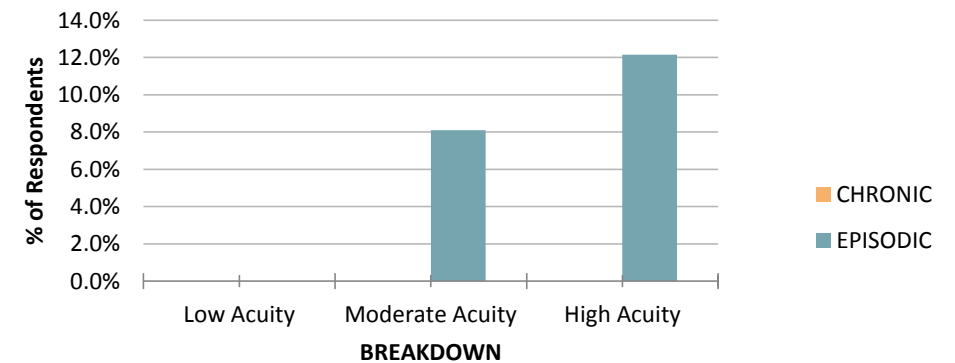

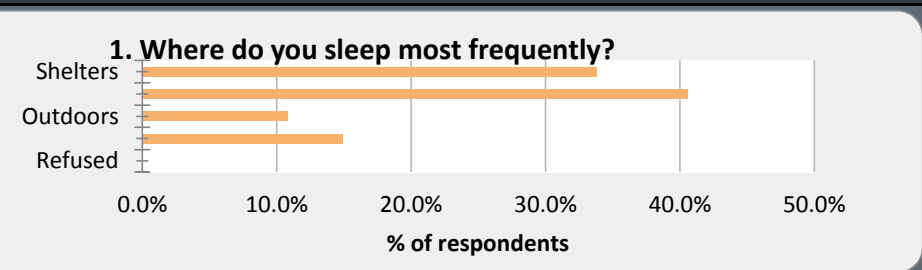

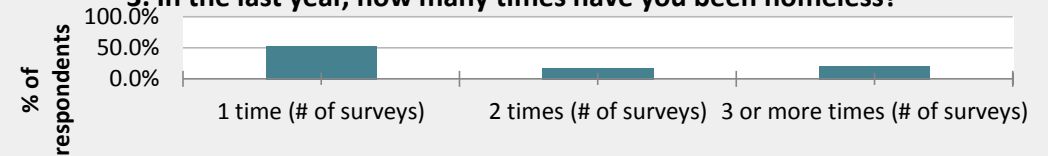

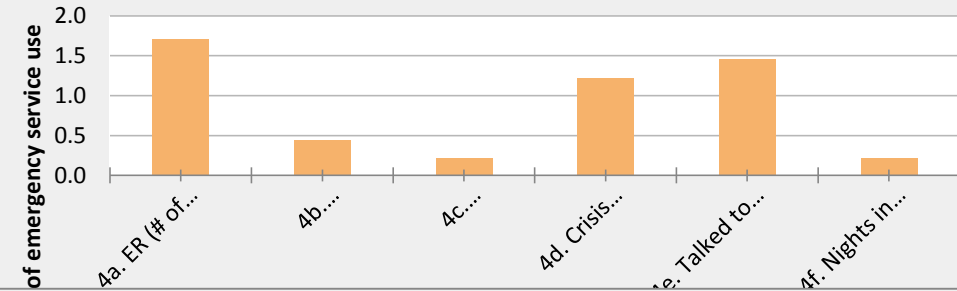

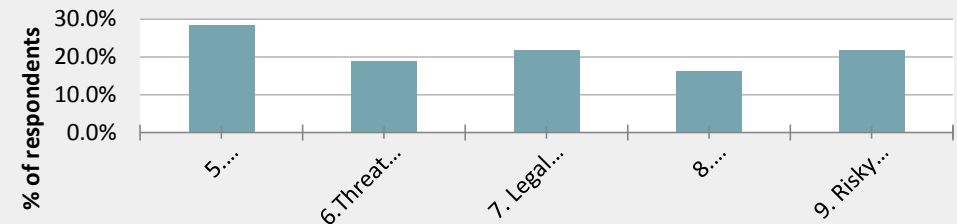

Emergency Service Usage in Past 6 Months

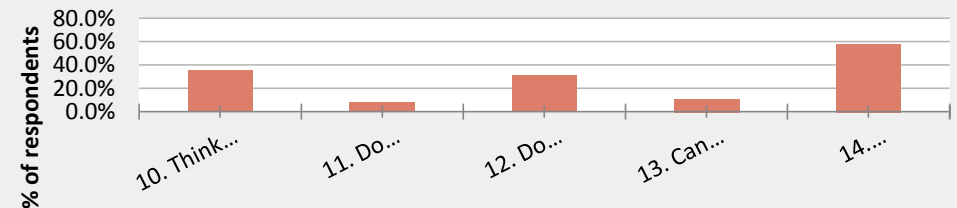

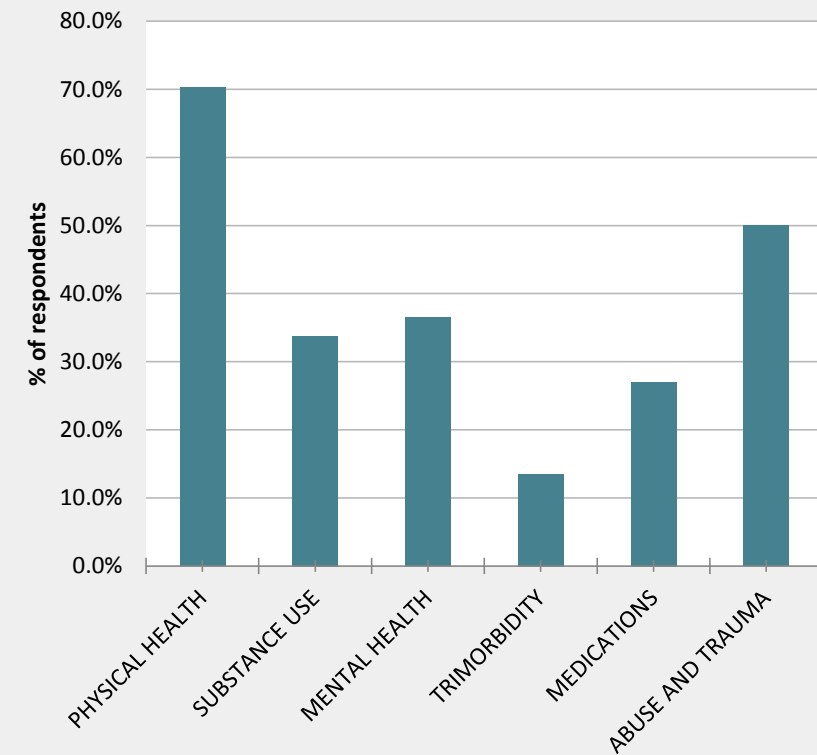

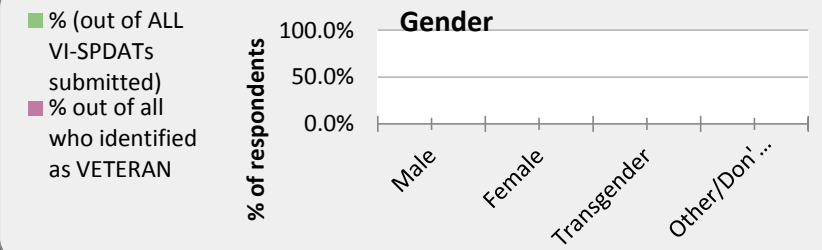
Emergency Service Usage in Past 6 Months



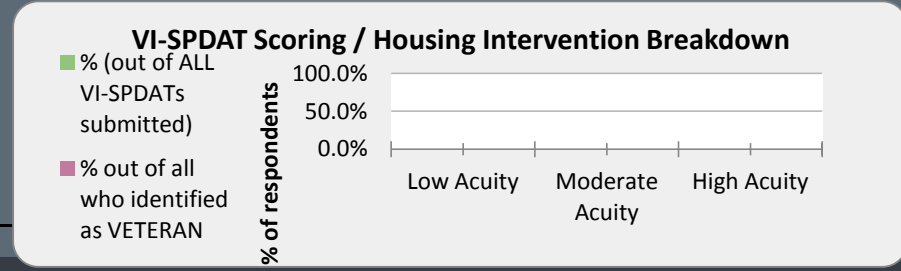
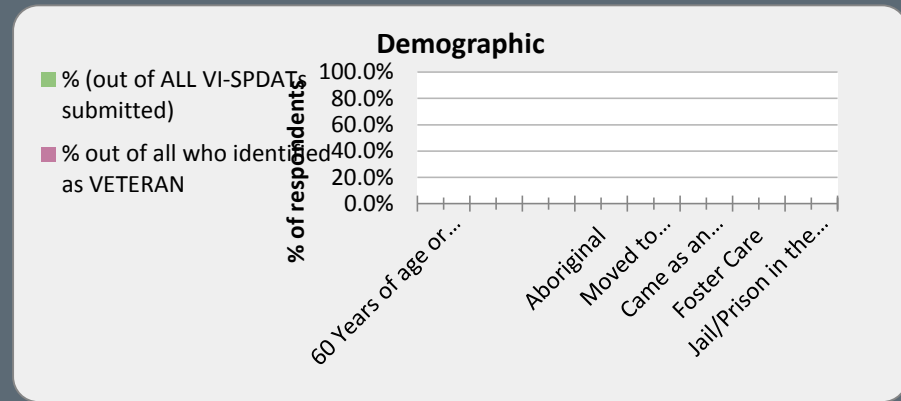

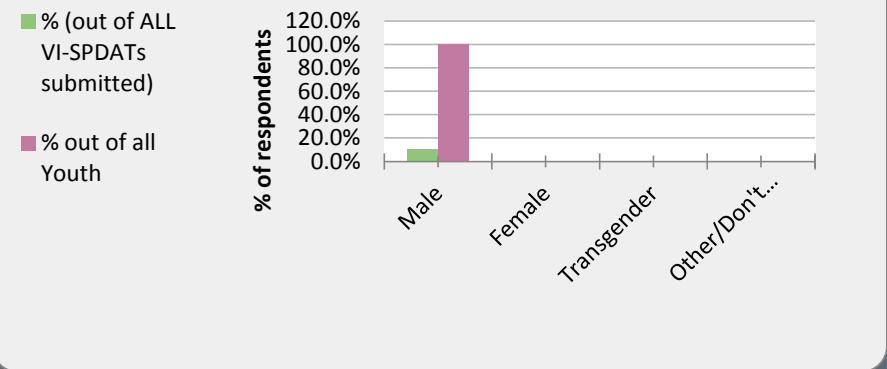
Emergency Service Usage in Past 6 Months

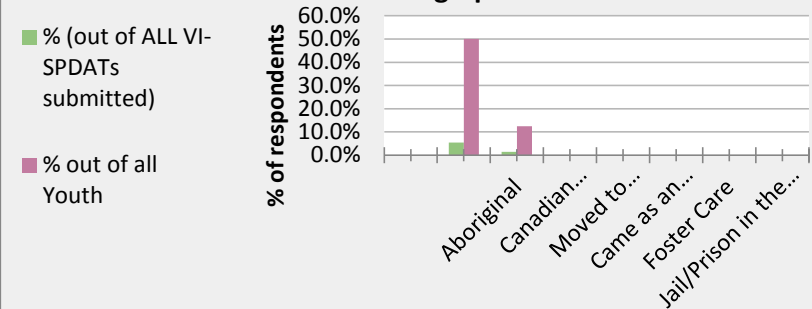
